## 2<sup>nd</sup> Landshut-Trophy in Trail Orienteering (TrailO)


**Saturday, 30<sup>th</sup> October 2021 in Hauslehen**



### Trail Orienteering - the inclusive brain sport with map and compass

Trail Orienteering (short: TrailO) is an orienteering sport that does not depend on fast locomotion, but even more on precise map reading. With the aid of a map and compass, orange/white control flags in the terrain must be assigned correctly from a distance. The athletes only move along a track, so TrailO is an ideal activity for people with physical impairments as well.

Event type:	PreO, individual competition
Ablauf:	at first each competitor has to absolve the PreO part with different number of controls – depending on the category. After the PreO part a timed control with three tasks has to be absolved.
Paths:	good, almost flat quality gravel road. Normal sport shoes are sufficient.
Terrain type:	mostly open terrain (former military training ground) with trees and tree groups, some controls will be placed in an open to dense mixed forest.
Map:	Orienteering map "Hauslehen", Scale 1:3000, Equidistance 2.5 m, ISSprOM 2019, mapped in October 2021, Size A4
Control system:	SPORTident for time keeping (start and finish), manual punchers for marking the controls. Please bring your own SI card and own puncher if possible. Both can be rented for free anyway.
Categories:	<p>Elite (E): 1000 m, 10 m ↗, 20 controls, 90 min. max. time, 1 timed contr. Average technical level, suitable for advanced orienteers with experience in map reading. Trophy category!</p> <p>Junior (J): 1000 m, 10 m ↗, 15 controls, 75 min. max. time, 1 timed contr. Average technical level, suitable for young orienteers (year of birth 2005 and younger) with basic knowledge in map reading. Trophy category!</p> <p>Beginner (A): 1000 m, 10 m ↗, 10 controls, 60 min. max. time, 1 timed contr. Easy to average technical level, suitable for orienteering newcomers of all age.</p> <p>For all who want to go on a run after the TrailO, we provide a foot orienteering course in free control order with MapRun app.</p>

Competition centre:	<p>Hiking parking at the southern edge of former military training ground Landshut (GPS 48. 48.546067, 12.222112). Approach via state road St2045 between Landshut and Adlkofen. At the crossing to Jenkofen turn to the opposite side direction Lernpoint and follow the road about 1 km to the parking. Please don't waste space when parking, as there can be lots of hikers and walkers, depending on the weather.</p>
Timetable:	<p>10:30 AM – event centre open</p> <p>10:45 AM – introduction in TrailO and the event (also at 11.30 and 12.15)</p> <p>11:00 AM - 12:30 PM – start corresponding to start list (2 minutes gap)</p> <p>2:00 PM – finish closing, followed by prize giving ceremony</p>
Prizes:	<p>Trophies for the winners, medals for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed runners in the trophy categories Elite (E) and Junior (J). Givaways for the first three athletes of all three categories.</p>
Hygienekonzept:	<p>To be able to organise the event during the covid19 pandemic it is necessary to follow our OLV Landshut hygiene concept for orienteering events.
